

PLANS FOR IMPROVEMENT as developed by the Steering Committee

- a. The success of the self-study process in identifying problems leads the Steering Committee to suggest that the same kind of participatory study can lead to the right solutions.
- b. It is the intention of the administration to ask that there be standing committees whose charge it is to develop strategic plans for each of the three areas named above in the "Areas of Improvement." These groups are scheduled to meet and start forming action plans by the end of June 1998.
- c. A representative group of teachers, support staff, and community members need to develop a school technology plan.
- d. Student groups who have met regularly during the self-study process need to be encouraged to continue meeting. Currently, student councils meet regularly during the day and evening at the Poplar Avenue site.
- e. Given the great need to improve current facilities at Poplar Avenue and find a new location for Foster City classes, the Steering Committee suggests that during spring, 1998, a representative group, including students and community members, meet to create a five-year plan for the improvement of our sites.

The follow-up activities will be monitored by the administration and Program Coordinators. The Visiting Committee senses there is reason to be optimistic about the integration of recommendations into future improvement efforts.

This Visiting Committee acknowledges that action plans with established timelines are not fully developed in this report for all areas.
