2. That district administration, school administration, and certificated staff develop and disseminate a technology plan for long-term purchases and maintenance in the adult education classrooms. 3. That the school administration identify a method to maintain functioning state-of-the-industry computer hardware to minimize the loss of instructional time. (School Report, Chpt. IX, Vocational Education, p. 2; Conferences with Community Committee, Program Specialist, Program Coordinators, Superintendent; WASC Criterion: Finance)
